- 3) Continually improving our performance relating to the above.

To achieve this all staff will need to be actively involved and so we have key performance indicators for 1 through 3 in all staff performance agreements.

Our method to achieve the desired outcomes is:

- Monthly at H&S&E meetings assess our activities and their effects upon the environment in a systematic and logical fashion.
- Identify the actions we need to take to address each effect.
- Set targets based on the actions we need to take.
- Monitor (normally monthly) our progress on each target

The key points of its strategy to achieve this are:

- Minimise waste by evaluating operations and ensuring they are as efficient as possible.
- Actively promote recycling both internally and amongst our customers and suppliers.
- Evaluate our supplier contracts to make sure those we align with share our aspirations for protecting the environment.
- Source and promote a product range to minimise the environmental impact of both production and distribution.
- Meet or exceed all the environmental legislation that relates to the Company.
- Audit our machinery for efficiency and life expectancies to minimise repairs and maintenance.
